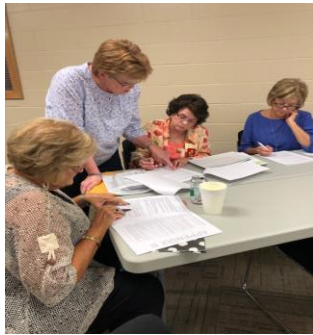

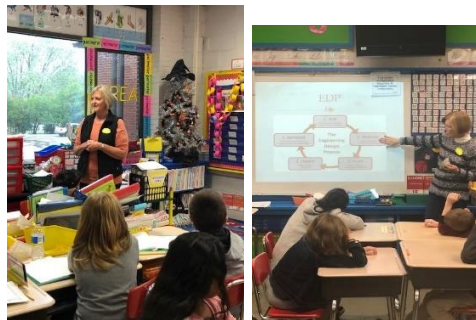
#### Education Excellence Committee Project
